TORINO R NET AIMS

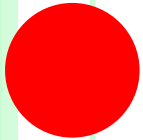
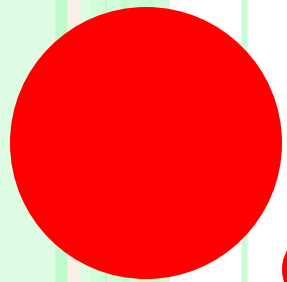
- Spur the adoption of R for innovative research and commercial applications
