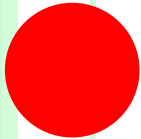

 - Organise focused events

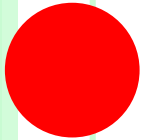
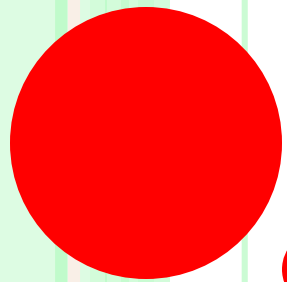
